Pat Powell attended the Walking Netball group at Silsoe. During her time with us she was very bubbly and enthusiastic and we often laughed at her understanding of the drills. She loved the tea and coffee and cake afterwards too.

Pat use to play and umpire netball in Bedfordshire and she ran a swimming school with her husband. Pat became unwell in March and after a short illness died in July. She died of a rare blood cancer - Waldenstrom's Macroglobulinema.



Funding

Netball East supports their affiliated members by providing UKCC course subsidies and mentoring opportunities to help develop coaches across the region.

Grants can be given towards UKCC level 1, 2 and the level 2 upgrade. Netball East is working with its county associations to provide a package for coaches, which should provide, in most cases, up to 75% of the cost of a course from the combined sources.
